TEXAS TROUT FLY FISHING TRIP

Location:	New Braunfels, Texas
Season:	November through May
Meeting Place:	Rio Raft - 14130 River Road The 4th Crossing on the Guadalupe River About 1/2 mile South of the Light at FM-2673 and River Rd.
Meeting Time:	8:00 am
Trip Duration:	Half Day & Full Day
Difficulty Level:	No previous experience needed to participate
Ages:	9 and up
Rates:	\$275 to \$350 (1-2 anglers)

The trout section of the Guadalupe River starts below Canyon Lake Dam in Comal County located between Austin and San Antonio. This is one of the southern most trout streams in North America and noted as one of the **100 Best Trout Stream in North America** by Trout Unlimited with about 10 miles of protected trout fishing.

The day starts by meeting at the designated put-in point of the river and rigging the boat and fishing equipment. The trip starts right when you're on the water, as majority of the fishing is done from the inflatable raft. The raft provides a comfortable ride, lots of storage, and a great vantage point which to fish! The guides are able to speak on a variety of subjects and teach or improve your fishing techniques while you are on the water.

At mid-day your trip will stop on the shores for a deli style lunch prepared by your guide. There's wade fishing opportunities for those who don't want to leave the water! After a short lunch break, we carry on down the river to cover the last of the roughly 6 to 9 miles of fishing and floating. We will arrive at the take-out point around 5 pm. This is subject to later arrival if the fishing is good and you are up for more time on the water. After loading the boat and gear you will be returned to your vehicle which is parked at the put-in point.

We recommend that you bring show you can get wet, a light rain jacket, polarized sunglasses, hat, and sun protection. A valid license is required.
