**SAN MARCOS BASS FLY FISHING TRIP**

These trips are conducted on the San Marcos River near the town of Martindale, which is located a few miles east of San Marcos. This river is a true gem of Texas. The river begins as a spring boiling up from the Edward Aquifer in San Marcos at a constant temperature of 70 degrees at a rate of 200 cfs. The Blanco River soon joins the river east of San Marcos adding nutrients and warmth. This area is one of the oldest continually habited places in the world because of these waters!

Our trips are targeting for a variety of bass species in including largemouth, smallmouth, and Guadalupe bass. The occasional Rio Grande Perch is always a welcomed achievement, as it is only found in this part of the world! Many anglers come to fish specifically for the Guadalupe bass and Rio Grande perch, as to mark them on their angling career species.

The day starts by meeting at the designated area and rigging the boat and fishing equipment. After a quick shuttle, the trip starts right when you're on the water, as majority of the fishing is done from the inflatable raft. The raft provides a comfortable ride, lots of storage, and a great vantage point which to fish! The guides are able to speak on a variety of subjects and teach or improve your fishing techniques while you are on the water.

At mid-day your trip will stop on the shores for a deli style lunch prepared by your guide. There's wade fishing opportunities for those who don't want to leave the water! After a short lunch break, we carry on down the river. We will arrive at the take-out point around 5 pm on Full-Day trips. This is subject to later arrival if the fishing is good and you are up for more time on the water. After loading the boat and gear you will be returned to your vehicle which is parked at the put-in point.

We recommend that you bring show you can get wet, a light rain jacket, polarized sunglasses, hat, and sun protection. A valid license is required.
